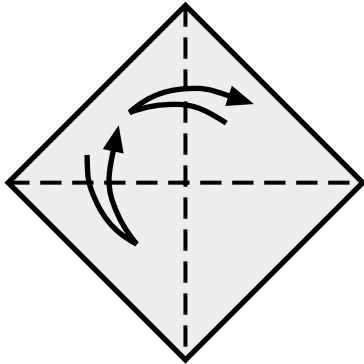
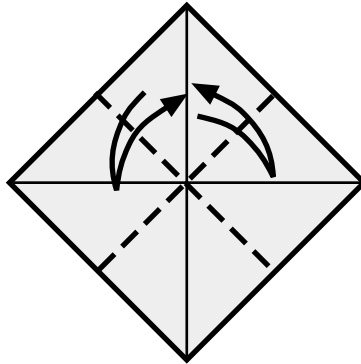


Zero-headed Crane

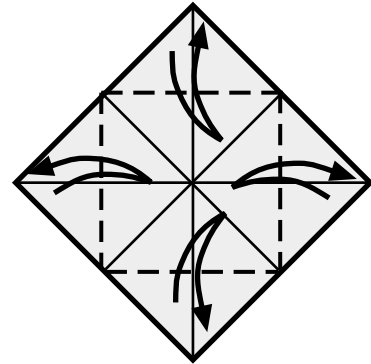

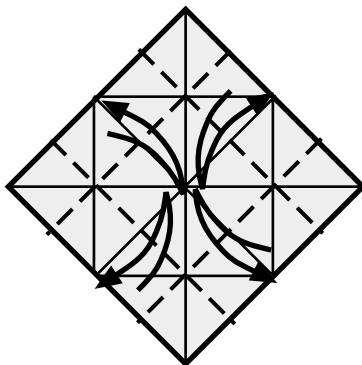
1. White side up.

along diagonals.



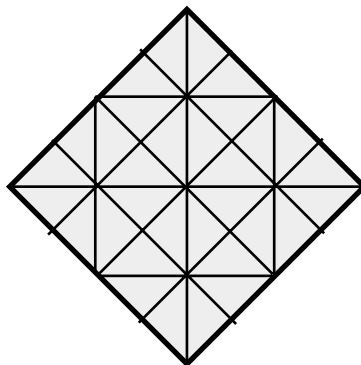
2. Fold in half and
unfold.



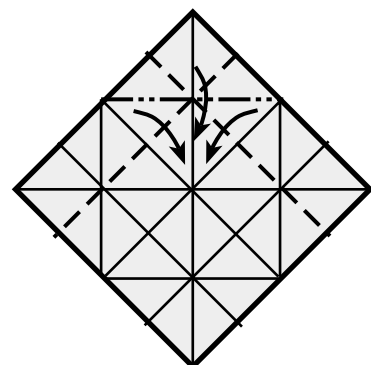
3. Fold corners to the
center and unfold.



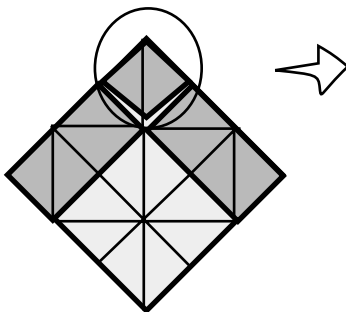
4. Fold sides to the
center and unfold.



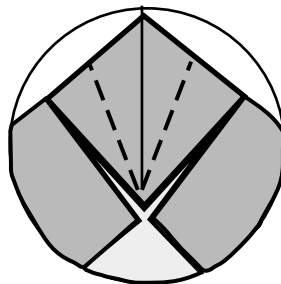
5. Completed
precreasing



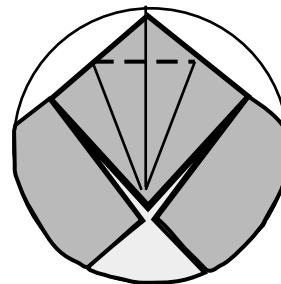
6. Collapse.



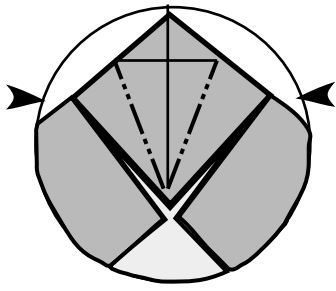
7. Paper should look
like this.



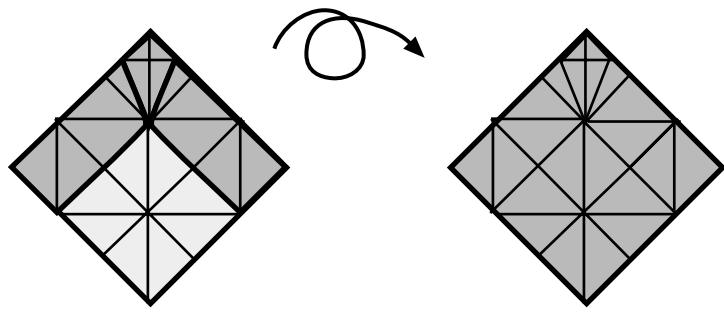
8. Enlarged view of

9. Fold and unfold..

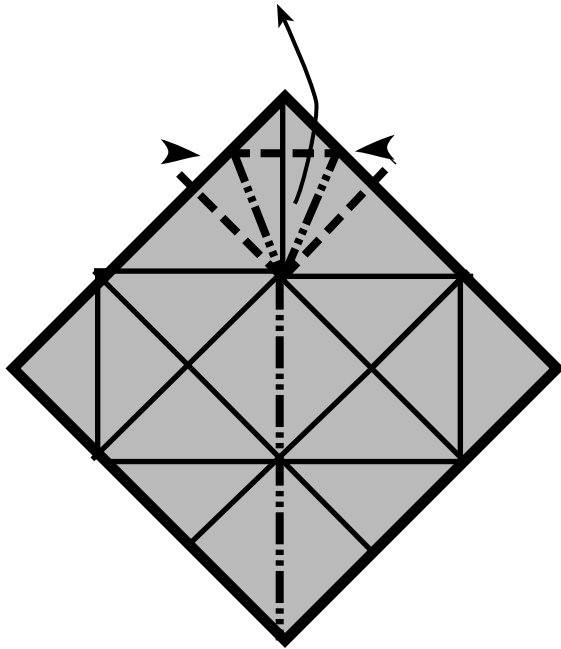


10. Reverse folds.

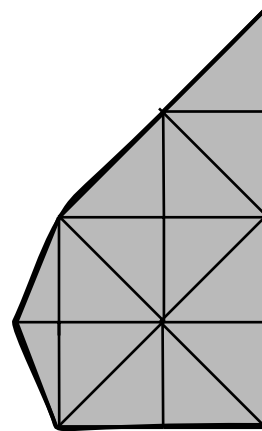

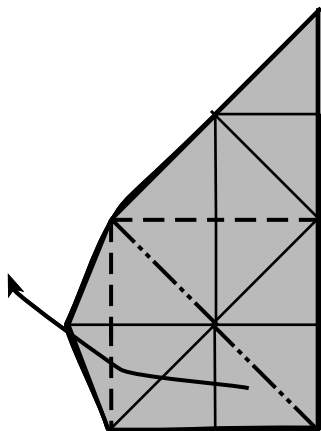

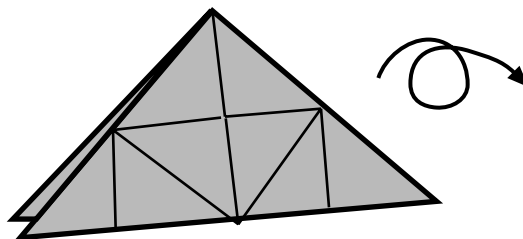
13. Enlarged view. This is basically a petal-fold, but with a lot of extra paper. Swing large flap to the right.



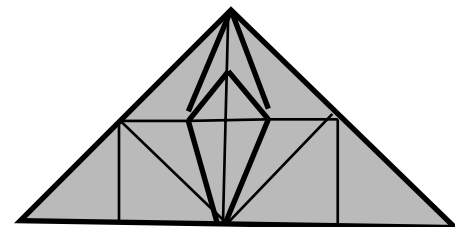
14. If you're lucky, and have done the previous step correctly, the paper should look like this.



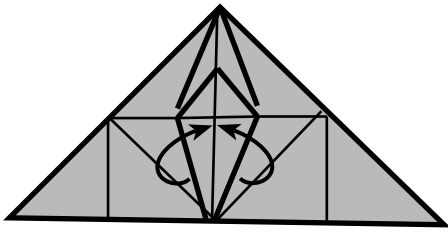
15. Swing corner flap to the left, allowing the top corner flap to swing down simultaneously.



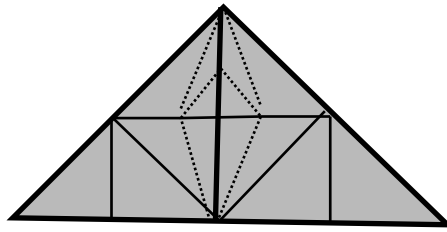
16. Shown staggered for clarity.



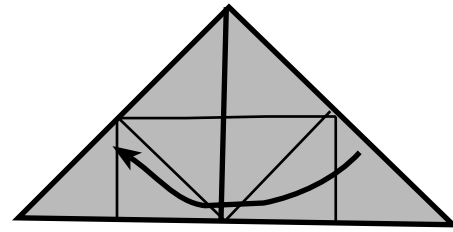
17. No longer staggered. There are two flaps on the right.



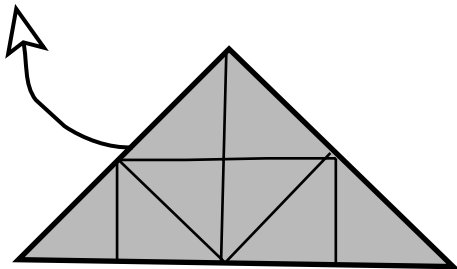
18. Bring a layer of paper to the front on each side. (closed sink)



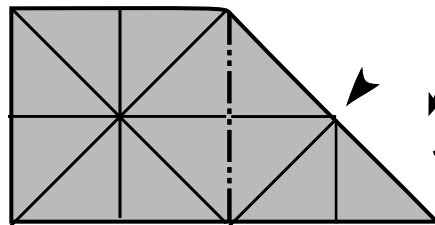
19. Model should look like this.



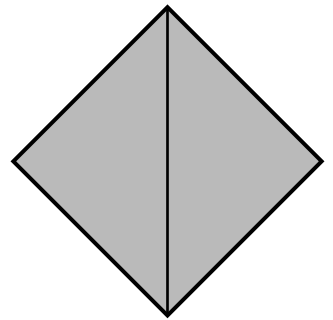
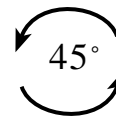
20. Swing one flap to the left.



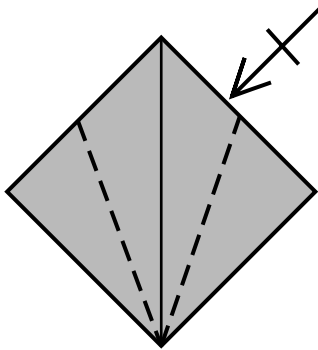
21. Pull out loose paper.



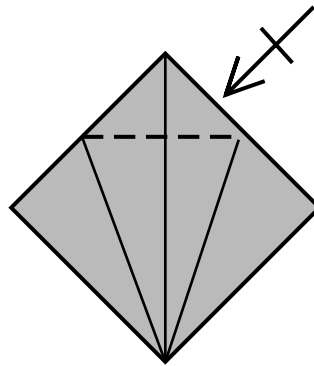
22. Reverse fold.



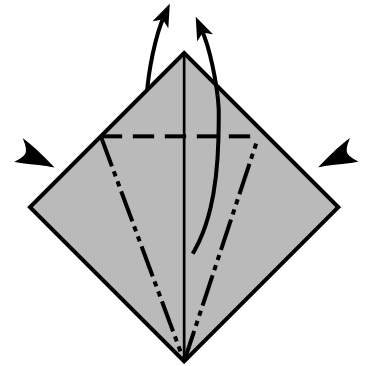
23. You now have a three-sided preliminary base. Ignore the other creases.



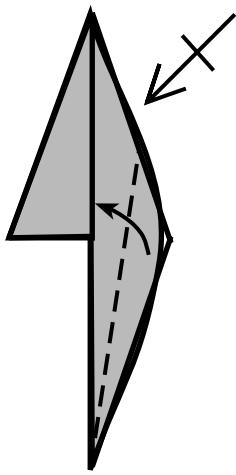
24. Valley fold to the center line. Unfold. Repeat behind.



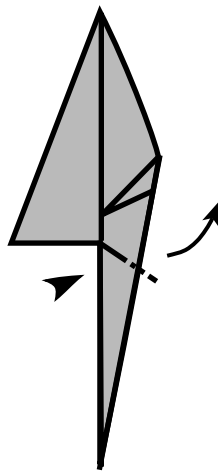
25. Valley fold and unfold. Repeat behind.



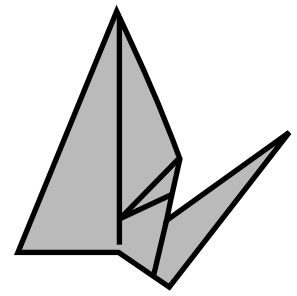
26. Petal-fold. Repeat behind.



27. Valley fold to the center line. Repeat behind.



28. Reverse fold to form tail..



29. Spread wings to inflate body. Some further shaping may be necessary.
